## **Ajashki is a vibrant and growing reconciliation program which needs your help to thrive!**

With an annual budget of approximately \$95,000, Ajashki (meaning “soil” in Algonquin) provides a safe place for marginalized Indigenous and non-Indigenous youth to learn about food security and climate change and to contribute to a larger community of care for each other and the planet. Our costs include paying a living wage to the 5-10 youth who attend (1-2 days/week) and the wage for the educator, an Algonquin horticulturalist.
